Re: Lead Testing

In an effort to increase the Lead Testing rates for children between the ages of 12 – 36 months, Health Plan of Michigan is pleased to announce the continuation of the Blood Lead Level Testing incentive program for County Health Departments.

For dates of service between 1/1/07 and 12/31/07, Health Plan of Michigan will reimburse County Health Departments a total of **\$25.00** for the coordination of each Blood Lead Level test performed on an HPM enrolled member between the ages of 12 – 36 months residing in that county.

All enrolled HPM members over the age of 36 months will not be part of this incentive program, but all covered services performed by the County Health Department will be reimbursed at 100% of current Medicaid rates.

Each test provided to an eligible HPM enrollee must be reported to the Michigan Department of Community Health. HPM will continue to supply Health Departments with a listing of all eligible HPM enrollees at the beginning of each month.

After coordinating the testing, the Health Department shall bill for the coordination of Blood Lead Level testing by completing a CMS-1500, using CPT Code 36416 with a modifier 22.
