

Health Plan of Michigan Maintains its “Excellent” Accreditation from NCQA

Health Plan of Michigan is pleased to announce that it has maintained its “Excellent” accreditation status from the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) for the fourth consecutive year. This determination was based upon NCQA’s review of HPM’s HEDIS 2008 and CAHPS 2008 scores.

The revised rankings also indicate which HEDIS measures rank in the NCQA 90th percentile. HPM is in the 90th percentile for the following measures:

- Childhood Immunization Status—Combo #2
- Breast Cancer Screening—Ages 52-69
- Prenatal and Postpartum Care
- Comprehensive Diabetes Care—HbA1c Testing
- Comprehensive Diabetes Care—HbA1c Poorly Controlled
- Comprehensive Diabetes Care—Eye Exams
- Comprehensive Diabetes Care—LDL Screening
- Comprehensive Diabetes Care—Nephropathy
- Appropriate Asthma Medications—Combined Rate
- Cholesterol Management—LDL Screening
