



Diabetes Control Network

The Diabetes Control Network (DCN) is a diabetes education program for HPM members and providers. DCN can help your patients learn more about diabetes and what they can do to help control it. This **free** program is sponsored by Pfizer Pharmaceuticals.

How this Program Works:

- All members with diabetes are mailed invitations to enroll in the DCN program by Health Plan of Michigan. This usually occurs in the first quarter of the year.
- HPM does not release any member names to the DCN program. DCN will only have a member name if the member enrolls in the program and provides the information on the enrollment form.
- Members enrolled in the DCN program will receive 12 mailings over the course of one year to support their efforts to get their HbA1c levels to goal and to encourage them to comply with glucose-lowering medication.
- Member mailings include a series of newsletters with relevant health issues, tips, and more. Members can also get additional support and access interactive tools on the Healthy at Heart website (www.healthyatheart.com).
- Providers were also mailed invitations to enroll in the DCN program by HPM. A provider may have received an invitation to enroll in this program by more than one health plan. You only need to enroll in this program once to start receiving the materials and information.
- HPM does not share any provider information with DCN. They will only have the provider information once the enrollment form is returned.

Benefits for Providers

- Enrolled health care providers receive an awareness mailing that will introduce the program.
- A series of professional newsletters will follow to provide information on clinical updates, study data, revised guidelines, practice-related trends and tips.
- Additional useful materials include exam room posters, monofilament, and other clinical tools.
